Hayes Family Wines is a small family-owned wine producer that has grown from a passion for Barossa Valley wines. The combination of exceptional food, wine and the friendly community in the Barossa Valley led us to purchase an old vineyard on an established 15 acre block in the prime location of Stone Well on the Western Ridge of the Barossa Valley.

As a boutique producer, we aim to create well-balanced wines that showcase the fruit flavour and structure of the traditional Barossa Valley varietals of Shiraz, Mataro, Grenache and Semillon. We are committed to producing premium Barossa wines from the best possible terroirs.

2017 Barossa Valley Shiraz

100% Shiraz coming from Ebenezer and Greenock vineyards in the Northern and North Western Barossa. Handpicked, hand sorted, destemmed, and open fermented before spending 16 days on skins. Matured for 16 months in a blend of new and second use French oak before being bottled in July 2018.

The wine is deep red tinged with purple. Classic northern Barossa flavours, dark fruits, earth, smoked meat, full bodied, but with a softness reflective of the milder weather we experienced in the 2017 vintage growing season. Substantial tannins provide a backbone that will support medium term cellaring. A wine that will age well but is drinking well on release.
